Abstract:

This paper will focus on female rock singers in Soviet and post-Soviet Russia and their (self)representation in creative work, media and popular discourses. Using case studies, drawing parallels from the Western rock culture and leaning on the modern gender theories, I explore the challenges that have always been present and that have arisen of late for Russian women – rock artists.
